1            AN ACT Relating to dedication of roadside safety rest areas; and  
2 adding a new section to chapter 47.38 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.38 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            The transportation commission may designate interstate safety rest  
7 areas, as appropriate, as locations for memorial signs to prisoners of  
8 war and those missing in action. The commission shall adopt policies  
9 for the placement of memorial signs on interstate safety rest areas and  
10 may disapprove any memorial sign that it determines to be inappropriate  
11 or inconsistent with the policies. The policies shall include, but are  
12 not limited to, guidelines for the size and location of and  
13 inscriptions on memorial signs. The secretary shall adopt rules for  
14 administering this program. Nonprofit associations may have their name  
15 identified on a memorial sign if the association bears the cost of  
16 supplying and maintaining the memorial sign.
