- 1 AN ACT Relating to requirements for retired active licenses for
- 2 health care practitioners; and amending RCW 18.130.250.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.130.250 and 1991 c 229 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 The disciplining authority may adopt rules pursuant to this section
- 7 authorizing a retired active license status. An individual
- 8 credentialed by a disciplining authority regulated in the state under
- 9 RCW 18.130.040, who is practicing only in emergent or intermittent
- 10 circumstances as defined by rule established by the disciplining
- 11 authority, may hold a retired active license at a reduced renewal fee
- 12 established by the secretary under RCW 43.70.250. Such a license shall
- 13 meet the continuing education or continued competency requirements, if
- 14 any, established by the disciplining authority for renewals, and is
- 15 subject to the provisions of this chapter. The disciplining authority
- 16 may adopt rules under this section that establish different continuing
- 17 <u>education requirements for retired active license holders who provide</u>
- 18 only uncompensated community services. Individuals who have entered
- 19 into retired status agreements with the disciplinary authority in any

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- 1 jurisdiction shall not qualify for a retired active license under this
- 2 section. The disciplinary authority may adopt by rule requirements to
- 3 be met by applicants holding a retired active license for reinstatement
- 4 or issuance of a regular license for resumption of full-time practice.

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
