- 1 AN ACT Relating to high school students' options; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 28A.600 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that students may have
- 5 difficulty attending community college for the purpose of the running
- 6 start program due to the distance of the nearest community college. In
- 7 these cases, it may be more advantageous for students in border
- 8 counties to attend community colleges in neighboring states. The
- 9 legislature encourages school districts to pursue interagency
- 10 agreements with community colleges in neighboring states when it is in
- 11 the best interests of the student's educational progress.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.600
- 13 RCW to read as follows:
- 14 School districts and out-of-state community colleges may enter into
- 15 cooperative agreements under chapter 39.34 RCW for the purpose of
