- 1 AN ACT Relating to commuter ride-sharing qualifications; and
- 2 amending RCW 46.74.010.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.74.010 and 1996 c 244 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The definitions set forth in this section shall apply throughout this chapter, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.
- 8 (1) "Commuter ride sharing" means a car pool or van pool
- 9 arrangement whereby ((a)) one or more fixed groups not exceeding
- 10 fifteen persons <u>each</u> including the drivers, and (a) not fewer than five
- 11 persons including the drivers, or (b) not fewer than four persons
- 12 including the drivers where at least two of those persons are confined
- 13 to wheelchairs when riding, ((is)) are transported in a passenger motor
- 14 vehicle with a gross vehicle weight not exceeding ten thousand pounds,
- 15 excluding special rider equipment, between their places of abode or
- 16 termini near such places, and their places of employment or educational
- 17 or other institutions, each group in a single daily round trip where
- 18 the drivers ((is)) are also on the way to or from ((his or her)) their
- 19 places of employment or educational or other institution.

- 1 (2) "Ride sharing for persons with special transportation needs"
 2 means an arrangement whereby a group of persons with special
 3 transportation needs, and their attendants, is transported by a public
 4 social service agency or a private, nonprofit transportation provider
 5 as defined in RCW 81.66.010(3) in a passenger motor vehicle as defined
 6 by the department to include small buses, cutaways, and modified vans
 7 not more than twenty-eight feet long: PROVIDED, That the driver need
 8 not be a person with special transportation needs.
- 9 (3) "Ride-sharing operator" means the person, entity, or concern, 10 not necessarily the driver, responsible for the existence and 11 continuance of commuter ride sharing or ride sharing for persons with 12 special transportation needs.
- 13 (4) "Persons with special transportation needs" means those persons 14 defined in RCW 81.66.010(4).
