- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.74.270 and 1993 c 293 s 6 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 ((Every)) \underline{A} person who maliciously places any explosive or
- 8 improvised device in, upon, under, against, or near any building, car,
- 9 vessel, railroad track, airplane, public utility transmission system,
- 10 or structure, in such manner or under such circumstances as to destroy
- 11 or injure it if exploded((, shall be punished as follows)) is quilty
- 12 of:
- 13 (1) Malicious placement of an explosive in the first degree if the
- 14 offense is committed with intent to commit a terrorist act. Malicious
- 15 placement of an explosive in the first degree is a class A felony;
- 16 (2) Malicious placement of an explosive in the second degree if the
- 17 offense is committed under circumstances not amounting to malicious
- 18 placement of an explosive in the first degree and if the circumstances
- 19 and surroundings are such that the safety of any person might be

- 1 endangered by the explosion((, by imprisonment in a state correctional))
- 2 facility for not more than twenty years;
- 3 (2) In every other case by imprisonment in a state correctional
- 4 facility for not more than five years)). Malicious placement of an
- 5 <u>explosive in the second degree is a class B felony;</u>
- 6 (3) Malicious placement of an explosive in the third degree if the
- 7 offense is committed under circumstances not amounting to malicious
- 8 placement of an explosive in the first or second degree. Malicious
- 9 placement of an explosive in the third degree is a class B felony.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 70.74 RCW
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 (1) A person who maliciously places any imitation device in, upon,
- 13 under, against, or near any building, car, vessel, railroad track,
- 14 airplane, public utility transmission system, or structure, with the
- 15 intent to give the appearance or impression that the imitation device
- 16 is an explosive or improvised device, is guilty of:
- 17 (a) Malicious placement of an imitation device in the first degree
- 18 if the offense is committed with intent to commit a terrorist act.
- 19 Malicious placement of an imitation device in the first degree is a
- 20 class B felony;
- 21 (b) Malicious placement of an imitation device in the second degree
- 22 if the offense is committed under circumstances not amounting to
- 23 malicious placement of an imitation device in the first degree.
- 24 Malicious placement of an imitation device in the second degree is a
- 25 class C felony.
- 26 (2) For purposes of this section, "imitation device" means a device
- 27 or substance that is not an explosive or improvised device, but which
- 28 by appearance or representation would lead a reasonable person to
- 29 believe that the device or substance is an explosive or improvised

- 31 **Sec. 3.** RCW 70.74.280 and 1992 c 7 s 50 are each amended to read
- 32 as follows:
- ((Every)) A person who ((shall)) maliciously, by the explosion of
- 34 gunpowder or any other explosive substance or material, destroy or
- 35 damage any building, car, airplane, vessel, common carrier, railroad
- 36 track, or public utility transmission system or structure((, shall be
- 37 punished as follows)) is guilty of:

- 1 (1) Malicious explosion of a substance in the first degree if the 2 offense is committed with intent to commit a terrorist act. Malicious 3 explosion of a substance in the first degree is a class A felony;
- 4 (2) Malicious explosion of a substance in the second degree if the
 5 offense is committed under circumstances not amounting to malicious
 6 explosion of a substance in the first degree and if thereby the life
 7 or safety of a human being is endangered((, by imprisonment in a state
 8 correctional facility for not more than twenty-five years;
- 9 (2) In every other case by imprisonment in a state correctional
 10 facility for not more than five years)). Malicious explosion of a
 11 substance in the second degree is a class A felony;
- (3) Malicious explosion of a substance in the third degree if the offense is committed under circumstances not amounting to malicious explosion of a substance in the first or second degree. Malicious explosion of a substance in the third degree is a class B felony.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 70.74 RCW to read as follows:
- For the purposes of sections 1 through 3 of this act "terrorist act" means an act that is intended to: (1) Intimidate or coerce a civilian population; (2) influence the policy of a branch or level of government by intimidation or coercion; (3) affect the conduct of a branch or level of government by intimidation or coercion; or (4) retaliate against a branch or level of government for a policy or conduct of the government.
