1 AN ACT Relating to designation of state route number 35; and adding
2 a new section to chapter 47.17 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.17 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 A state highway to be known as state route number 35 is established
7 as follows:

8 Beginning at the Washington-Oregon boundary line thence northerly
9 to a junction with state route number 14 in the vicinity of White
10 Salmon; however, until such time as a bridge across the Columbia River
11 is constructed at a location adopted by the transportation commission
12 no existing route may be maintained or improved by the transportation
13 commission as a temporary route for state route number 35.
