- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 The chief clerk of the house of representatives and the secretary
- 9 of the senate shall prepare vouchers for the state treasurer for sums
- 10 covering amounts due a school district for any teacher who is on a
- 11 leave of absence as a legislator, and who has chosen to continue
- 12 insurance benefits provided by the school district, in lieu of
- 13 insurance benefits provided to that legislator as a state employee.
- 14 The amount of reimbursement due the school district is for the actual
- 15 cost of continuing benefits, but may not exceed the cost of the
- 16 insurance benefits package that would otherwise be provided through the
- 17 health care authority.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 The authority shall adopt rules that provide for members of the
- 4 legislature who choose reimbursement under section 1 of this act in
- 5 lieu of insurance benefits under this chapter.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Upon presentation to the state treasurer of a warrant issued by the
- 9 treasurer and drawn for the purposes under section 1 of this act, the
- 10 treasurer shall pay the amount necessary from appropriated funds. If
- 11 sufficient funds have not been appropriated, the treasurer shall
- 12 endorse the warrant and the warrant draws interest from the date of the
- 13 endorsement until paid.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 15 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 16 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 17 immediately.
