Expert now estimate hat more health are workers will eventual by ie due to complication on occupation exposure to Hepatit Is than from HIV.

SUMMARY: The Departmentof Laborand Industry L&I must adopt emergency rule by September 1999 (and six months after dopt permanent rules over ning ccupation & kposure to blood born pathogens such as Hepatit Esvirus Hepatit is virus and HIV.

The emergencyrulesmust requireachemployertoconductproductevaluations needleless systems and sharps which must be conducted by front-lineal thrareworkers representing wards and medical special times are they are used. The productevaluation periods hould continue omotless than six months from the date of commencement.

L&I must considered ition at vision the blood born pathogens tandard oprevents harps in juries exposure incident including raining of education at equirement seasures to increase accination strategipd accement of sharps container and increased se of personal protective quipment.
