1 AN ACT Relating to air pollution control authority boards of
2 directors; and amending RCW 70.94.100.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.94.100 and 1991 c 199 s 704 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The governing body of each authority shall be known as the
7 board of directors.

8 (2) In the case of an authority comprised of one county the board
9 shall be comprised of two appointees of the city selection committee,
10 at least one of whom shall represent the city having the most
11 population in the county, and two representatives to be designated by
12 the board of county commissioners. In the case of an authority
13 comprised of two, three, four, or five counties, the board shall be
14 comprised of one appointee from each county, who shall represent the
15 city having the most population in such county, to be designated by the
16 mayor and city council of such city, and one representative from each
17 county to be designated by the board of county commissioners of each
18 county making up the authority. In the case of an authority comprised
19 of six or more counties, the board shall be comprised of one

1 representative from each county to be designated by the board of county
2 commissioners of each county making up the authority, and three
3 appointees, one each from the three largest cities within the local
4 authority's jurisdiction to be appointed by the mayor and city council
5 of such city.

6 (3) In the case of an authority comprised of one county, that has
7 a population over three hundred fifty thousand and that is located east
8 of the crest of the Cascades, the board shall be comprised of one
9 appointee of the city selection committee, one appointee who shall be
10 appointed by the legislative authority of and represent the city having
11 the most population in the county, and two representatives to be
12 designated by the county legislative authority.

13 (4) If the board of an authority otherwise would consist of an even
14 number, the members selected as above provided shall agree upon and
15 elect an additional member who shall be either a member of the
16 (~~governing body~~) legislative authority of one of the towns, cities,
17 or counties comprising the authority, or a private citizen residing in
18 the authority.

19 (~~(4)~~) (5) The terms of office of board members shall be four
20 years.

21 (~~(5)~~) (6) Wherever a member of a board has a potential conflict
22 of interest in an action before the board, the member shall declare to
23 the board the nature of the potential conflict prior to participating
24 in the action review. The board shall, if the potential conflict of
25 interest, in the judgment of a majority of the board, may prevent the
26 member from a fair and objective review of the case, remove the member
27 from participation in the action.
