- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 44.04 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Upon petition by a member of the legislature, any instance where a
- 7 state agency has a legislatively mandated requirement to report to the
- 8 legislature or legislative committees regarding a specific matter by a
- 9 date certain is subject to selective review by the joint administrative
- 10 rules review committee. If the committee finds by a majority vote of
- 11 its membership that the agency either failed to report to the
- 12 legislature by the specified time or failed to provide a report that
- 13 was sufficiently responsive to the legislation requiring the report,
- 14 the committee may request of the governor and the head of the reporting
- 15 agency, to give a written response within five working days of the date
- 16 of the request, as to the reasons why the requirement has not been met
- 17 and the date certain by which the requirement will be met.
