- 1 AN ACT Relating to child care access; adding a new section to

- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that low-income
- 5 parents who are attempting to enhance their work skills through
- 6 education, while at the same time complying with the work activity
- 7 requirements of chapter 74.08A RCW, should be encouraged to pursue
- 8 their academic goals. The legislature further finds that persons who
- 9 are going to school at the same time as they are engaging in work
- 10 activities need assistance in overcoming barriers to further education,
- 11 one of which is access to affordable child care.
- 12 It is the intent of the legislature to support these low-income
- 13 working parents by providing them with child care benefits while they

- 4 (2) The department may, to the extent funds are available, provide 5 payments under subsection (1) of this section beginning not later than 6 July 1, 1999.
- 7 (3) The department may adopt rules to determine eligibility for 8 child care benefits under subsection (1) of this section.
