- 6 (1) ((At the request of an applicant,)) The department of health,
- 7 in consultation with the department of ecology and local health
- 8 departments((<del>, may</del>)) shall evaluate the environmental and public health
- 9 impacts of biomedical waste treatment technologies. The evaluation
- 10 shall be consistent with the quidelines established by the state and
- 11 <u>territorial association on alternative treatment technologies.</u> The
- 12 department shall make available the results of any evaluation to local
- 13 health departments.
- 14 (2) All direct costs associated with the evaluation shall be paid
- 15 by the applicant to the department of health or to a state or local
- 16 entity designated by the department of health.
- 17 (3) For the purposes of this section, "applicant" means any person
- 18 representing a biomedical waste treatment technology that seeks ((an
