- AN ACT Relating to investigations of abuse or neglect; adding a new

- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the parent,
- 5 guardian, or foster parent of a child who may be the victim of abuse or
 - neglect may become involved in the investigation of the abuse or
- 7 neglect. The parent, guardian, or foster parent may also be made a
- 8 party to later court proceedings and be subject to a court-ordered
- 9 examination by a physician, psychologist, or psychiatrist. It is the
- 10 intent of the legislature to avoid actual or perceived conflicts of
- 11 interest that may occur when the parent, guardian, or foster parent is
- 12 also a law enforcement officer and is assigned to conduct the
- 13 investigation of alleged abuse or neglect concerning the child.
