- 1 AN ACT Relating to fertilizer labeling language; amending RCW
- 2 15.54.340; adding a new section to chapter 15.54 RCW; creating a new
- 3 section; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 15.54.340 and 1998 c 36 s 6 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) Any commercial fertilizer distributed in this state shall have
- 8 placed on or affixed to the package a label setting forth in clearly
- 9 legible and conspicuous form the following information:
- 10 (a) The net weight;
- 11 (b) The product name, brand, and grade. The grade is not required
- 12 if no primary nutrients are claimed;
- 13 (c) The guaranteed analysis;
- 14 (d) The name and address of the registrant or licensee. The name
- 15 and address of the manufacturer, if different from the registrant or
- 16 licensee, may also be stated;
- 17 (e) Any information required under WAC 296-62-054;
- (f) (i) For products labeled by July 1, 1999, at a minimum, the
- 19 following labeling statement: (("This product has been registered with

- 1 the Washington State Department of Agriculture. When applied as
- 2 directed, this fertilizer meets the Washington standards for arsenic,
- 3 cadmium, cobalt, mercury, molybdenum, lead, nickel, selenium, and zinc.
- 4 You have the right to receive specific information about Washington
- 5 standards from the distributor of this product.";
- 6 (g) After July 1, 1999, the label must also state:)) "Information
- 7 received by the Washington State Department of Agriculture regarding
- 8 the components in this product is available on the internet at
- 9 http://www.wa.gov/agr/ $((\cdot))$ ";
- 10 (ii) For products not labeled by July 1, 1999, and for all products
- 11 after July 1, 2000, at a minimum, the following statement:
- 12 "Information regarding the levels of metals in this product is
- 13 <u>available on the internet at http://www.wa.gov/agr/";</u> and
- $((\frac{h}{h}))$ (g) Other information as required by the department by
- 15 rule.
- 16 (2) If a commercial fertilizer is distributed in bulk, a written or
- 17 printed statement of the information required by subsection (1) of this
- 18 section shall accompany delivery and be supplied to the purchaser at
- 19 the time of delivery.
- 20 (3) Each delivery of a customer-formula fertilizer shall be subject
- 21 to containing those ingredients specified by the purchaser, which
- 22 ingredients shall be shown on the statement or invoice with the amount
- 23 contained therein, and a record of all invoices of customer-formula
- 24 grade mixes shall be kept by the registrant or licensee for a period of
- 25 twelve months and shall be available to the department upon request:
- 26 PROVIDED, That each such delivery shall be accompanied by either a
- 27 statement, invoice, a delivery slip, or a label if bagged, containing
- 28 the following information: The net weight; the brand; the guaranteed

- 29 analysis which may be stated to the nearest tenth of a percent or to
- 30 the next lower whole number; the name and address of the registrant or
- 31 licensee, or manufacturer, or both; and the name and address of the
- 32 purchaser.
- 33 (((4) Any person who distributes a commercial fertilizer in this
- 34 state shall make available to the purchaser on request, a copy of
- 35 standards for metals established in RCW 15.54.800.))
- 36 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** By January 1, 2000, the department of
- 37 agriculture shall establish guidelines recommending the size of the
- 38 type for the label requirement in RCW 15.54.340(1)(f).

- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 15.54 RCW to read as follows:
- 3 Specialty fertilizers are exempt from the labeling requirements in
- 4 RCW 15.54.340(1)(f) if there is a label setting forth in clearly
- 5 legible and conspicuous form the registrant's or licensee's website
- 6 placed on or affixed to the package. In order to qualify for this
- 7 exemption, the website must also have a hypertext link to
- 8 http://www.wa.gov/agr and contain a statement that information on the
- 9 metal content of the product is available on that website.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 11 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 12 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 13 July 1, 1999.
