- 1 AN ACT Relating to the Lewis and Clark bicentennial advisory
- 2 committee; creating new sections; repealing RCW 27.34.340; and
- 3 providing an expiration date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The Lewis and Clark bicentennial advisory
- 6 committee is created under the auspices of the Washington state
- 7 historical society. The committee shall consist of fifteen members, as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Six citizen members, at least three of whom must be enrolled
- 10 members of a Washington Indian tribe, who shall be appointed by the
- 11 governor;
- 12 (2) The president of the Washington state historical society;
- 13 (3) The director of the Washington state parks and recreation
- 14 commission;
- 15 (4) The secretary of the Washington state department of
- 16 transportation;
- 17 (5) The director of the Washington state department of community,
- 18 trade, and economic development;

- 1 (6) Four members of the Washington state legislature, one from each
- 2 caucus in the senate and the house of representatives as designated by
- 3 each caucus; and
- 4 (7) The chair of the Lewis and Clark trail advisory committee.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) The Lewis and Clark bicentennial
- 6 committee shall coordinate and provide guidance to Washington's
- 7 observance of the bicentennial of the Lewis and Clark expedition. The
- 8 committee may:

- 9 (a) Cooperate with national, regional, state-wide, and local events
- 10 promoting the bicentennial;
  - (b) Assist, plan, or conduct bicentennial events;
- 12 (c) Engage in or encourage fund-raising activities including
- 13 revenue-generating enterprises, as well as the solicitation of
- 14 charitable gifts, grants, or donations;
- 15 (d) Promote public education concerning the importance of the Lewis
- 16 and Clark expedition in American history, including the role of Native
- 17 people in making the expedition a success;
- 18 (e) Coordinate interagency participation in the observance; and
- 19 (f) Perform other related duties.
- 20 (2) The committee is attached to the Washington state historical

- 33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The Lewis and Clark bicentennial account is
- 34 created in the state treasury. Expenditures from the account may only
- 35 be expended to finance the activities of the Lewis and Clark
- 36 bicentennial committee and all expenditures must be authorized by the
- 37 director of the Washington state historical society or the director's

- 1 designee. Moneys in the account may only be spent after appropriation.
- 2 The account is subject to the allotment procedures under chapter 43.88
- 3 RCW.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Sections 1 through 3 of this act expire June
- 5 30, 2007.
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** RCW 27.34.340 and 1996 c 65 s 1 are each
- 7 repealed.
