- 1 AN ACT Relating to proof of financial responsibility or motor
- 2 vehicle liability insurance; and amending RCW 46.16.212, 46.16.210, and
- 3 46.30.040.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.16.212 and 1989 c 353 s 10 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) The department of licensing shall notify the public of the
- 8 requirements of RCW 46.30.020 through 46.30.040 at the time of new
- 9 vehicle registration and when the department sends a registration
- 10 renewal notice.
- 11 (2) When the department sends a vehicle license renewal notice, it
- 12 shall also provide notice of the requirement for written proof of
- 13 meeting the financial responsibility requirements in order to renew the
- 14 license.
- 15 (3) The department shall not renew a vehicle license due for
- 16 renewal January 1, 2000, or after unless the applicant provides written
- 17 proof of meeting the financial responsibility requirements for
- 18 operating a motor vehicle as provided in RCW 46.30.020.

- (1) Upon receipt of the application and proper fee for <u>an</u> original vehicle license, the director shall make a recheck of the application and in the event that there is any error in the application it may be returned to the county auditor or other agent to effectively secure the correction of such error, who shall return the same corrected to the director.
- 9 (2) Application for the renewal of a vehicle license shall be made 10 to the director or his agents, including county auditors, by the registered owner on a form prescribed by the director. The application 11 must be accompanied by the certificate of registration for the last 12 13 registration period in which the vehicle was registered in Washington unless the applicant submits a preprinted application mailed from 14 15 Olympia, and the payment of such license fees and excise tax as may be 16 required by law. Such application shall be handled in the same manner 17 and the fees transmitted to the state treasurer in the same manner as in the case of an original application. Any such application which 18 19 upon validation becomes a renewal certificate need not have entered upon it the name of the lien holder, if any, of the vehicle concerned. 20
 - (3) Persons expecting to be out of the state during the normal renewal period of a vehicle license may secure renewal of such vehicle license and have license plates or tabs preissued by making application to the director or his agents upon forms prescribed by the director. The application must be accompanied by the certificate of registration for the last registration period in which the vehicle was registered in Washington and be accompanied by such license fees, and excise tax as may be required by law.
- (4) Every applicant for renewal of a vehicle license due for 29 30 renewal January 1, 2000, or after shall provide current proof of financial responsibility to operate a vehicle as required in RCW 31 46.30.020. The department may adopt rules regarding valid proof of 32 financial responsibility for persons renewing a vehicle license. The 33 34 department shall reimburse its agents, including county auditors, for the mailing costs of returning license renewal applications that are 35 submitted without proof of financial responsibility. 36
- 37 (5) Application for the annual renewal of a vehicle license number 38 plate to the director or the director's agents shall not be required 39 for those vehicles owned, rented, or leased by the state of Washington,

- 1 or by any county, city, town, school district, or other political
- 2 subdivision of the state of Washington or a governing body of an Indian
- 3 tribe located within this state and recognized as a governmental entity
- 4 by the United States department of the interior.
- 5 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.30.040 and 1991 sp.s. c 25 s 2 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Any person who knowingly provides false evidence of financial
- 8 responsibility to a law enforcement officer $((\frac{or}{or}))_{\perp}$ to a court, or to
- 9 the department of licensing on an application for renewal of a vehicle
- 10 <u>license</u>, including an expired or canceled insurance policy, bond, or
- 11 certificate of deposit is guilty of a misdemeanor.
