- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes that the
- 6 department of corrections canine training program is vital for
- 7 preventing the use of illegal narcotics at department of corrections
- 8 facilities. However, by providing canine training to local governments
- 9 and other states at a substantially lower rate than private industry,
- 10 the department is in direct competition with private businesses
- 11 providing canine training.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 72.09 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 The department may provide canine training to meet the department's
- 15 internal needs. The department may not provide canine training to any
