- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.79 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Subject to appropriation, the department is authorized to acquire
- 7 by purchase, lease, condemnation, gift, devise, bequest, grant, or
- 8 exchange, title to or any interests or rights in real property adjacent
- 9 to or used in association with state intercity passenger rail service
- 10 which may include, but are not limited to, depots, platforms, parking
- 11 areas, and maintenance facilities. The department is authorized to
- 12 contract with a public or private entity for the operation,
- 13 maintenance, and/or management of these facilities.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 47.79 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
- Subject to appropriation, the department is authorized to accept
- 17 and expend or use gifts, grants, and donations for the benefit of any
- 18 depot, platform, parking area, maintenance facility, or other

- 1 associated rail facility. However, such an expenditure shall be for 2 the public benefit of the state's intercity passenger rail service.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 47.79 RCW to read as follows:
- 5 Subject to appropriation, the department is authorized to exercise all the powers and perform all the duties necessary, convenient, or 6 7 incidental to the planning, designing, constructing, improving, repairing, operating, and maintaining real property adjacent to or used 8 9 in association with the state intercity passenger rail service which may include, but are not limited to, depots, platforms, parking areas, 10 and maintenance facilities, even if such real property is owned or 11 controlled by another entity. However, any expenditure of public funds 12 for these purposes shall be directly related to public benefit of the 13 14 state's intercity passenger rail service. The department shall enter 15 into a written contract with the affected real property owners to secure the public's investment. 16
