- 1 AN ACT Relating to administrative rule making; adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 34.05 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that:
- 5 (1) The regulated community is composed largely of people who try
- 6 to comply with the rules they are aware of, but who are often
- 7 frustrated by the complexity of the regulatory system.
- 8 (2) Agencies use old laws to adopt new rules without returning to
- 9 the legislature for authorization.
- 10 It is the intent of the legislature to correct this problem by
- 11 requiring agencies to return to the legislature after two years for
- 12 authorization to adopt new rules.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 34.05 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, an
- 16 agency's statutory authority to adopt new rules or amend previously
- 17 adopted rules expires two years after the effective date of any statute
- 18 that the agency cites as its authority for adopting the new or amended
