- 1 AN ACT Relating to abandoned fishing nets; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 75.08 RCW; creating a new section; and making an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that:
- 5 (1) Abandoned fishing nets are a problem that pose a risk to the 6 state's precious salmon resource;
- 7 (2) Because these nets often exist below the surface of the water,
- 8 they pose a unique challenge to locate and require a dedicated effort
- 9 to remove; and
- 10 (3) There are private agencies interested in partnering with the
- 11 state to remove this threat.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 75.08 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 The department shall oversee and coordinate action to locate and
- 15 remove abandoned fishing nets that are adrift in the waters of the
- 16 state. The department may solicit assistance from private
- 17 organizations to carry out efforts to locate and remove abandoned nets
- 18 in the most cost-effective manner possible. The department may accept

- 1 useful donations of private materials, funds, or labor in order to
- 2 locate and remove abandoned nets. The department shall report back to
- 3 the legislature before February 1, 2000, on the progress of this
- 4 program.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The sum of two hundred thousand dollars, or
- 6 as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the fiscal
- 7 year ending June 30, 2000, from the general fund to the department of
- 8 fish and wildlife for the purposes of this act.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** If any provision of this act or its
- 10 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 11 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 12 persons or circumstances is not affected.
