- 1 AN ACT Relating to expanding membership of the electrical board by
- 2 appointment of one outside line worker; amending RCW 19.28.065; and
- 3 creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 19.28.065 and 1988 c 81 s 4 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) There is hereby created an electrical board, consisting of
- 8 ((ten)) eleven members to be appointed by the governor with the advice
- 9 of the director of labor and industries as herein provided. It shall
- 10 be the purpose and function of the board to advise the director on all
- 11 matters pertaining to the enforcement of this chapter including, but
- 12 not limited to standards of electrical installation, minimum inspection
- 13 procedures, and the adoption of rules and regulations pertaining to the
- 14 electrical inspection division: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That no rules or
- 15 regulations shall be amended or repealed until the electrical board has
- 16 first had an opportunity to consider any proposed amendments or repeals
- 17 and had an opportunity to make recommendations to the director relative
- 18 thereto.

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- 1 (2) The members of the electrical board shall be selected and 2 appointed as follows:
- 3 (a) One member shall be an employee or officer of a corporation or 4 public agency generating or distributing electric power;
- 5 <u>(b) Three</u> members shall be licensed electrical contractors((÷ 6 PROVIDED, That)). However, one of these members may be a representative of a trade association in the electrical industry;
- 8 <u>(c) One member shall be an employee, or officer, or representative</u>
 9 of a corporation or firm engaged in the business of manufacturing or
 10 distributing electrical materials, equipment, or devices;
- 11 <u>(d) One member shall be a person with knowledge of the electrical</u>
 12 industry, not related to the electrical industry, to represent the
 13 public;
- 14 <u>(e) Three members shall be certified electricians; ((and))</u>
- (f) One member shall be a licensed professional electrical engineer qualified to do business in the state of Washington; and
- 17 (q) One member shall be an outside line worker.
- (3) The regular term of each member shall be four years((÷ 18 19 PROVIDED, HOWEVER,)). The original board shall be appointed on June 9, 1988((, for the following terms:)). The first term of the member 20 representing a corporation or public agency generating or distributing 21 electric power shall serve four years; two members representing 22 licensed electrical contractors shall serve three years; the member 23 24 representing a manufacturer or distributor of electrical equipment or 25 devices shall serve three years; the member representing the public and one member representing licensed electrical contractors shall serve two 26 years; the three members selected as certified electricians shall serve 27 for terms of one, two, and three years, respectively; the member 28 selected as the licensed professional electrical engineer shall serve 29 30 for one year. The first term for the member representing outside line In appointing the original board, the 31 workers is for four years. governor shall give due consideration to the value of continuity in 32 33 membership from predecessor boards. ((Thereafter,))
- 34 <u>(4) The governor shall appoint or reappoint board members for terms</u>
 35 of four years and to fill vacancies created by the completion of the
 36 terms of the original members. The governor shall also fill vacancies
 37 caused by death, resignation, or otherwise for the unexpired term of
 38 such members by appointing their successors from the same business

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1 classification. The same procedure shall be followed in making such 2 subsequent appointments as is provided for the original appointments.

3 (5) The board, at ((this)) its first meeting after the effective 4 date of this act shall elect one of its members to serve as ((chairman)) chair. Any person acting as the chief electrical 5 inspector shall serve as secretary of the board during his or her 6 7 tenure as chief state inspector. Meetings of the board shall be held 8 at least quarterly in accordance with a schedule established by the 9 Each member of the board shall receive compensation in accordance with RCW 43.03.240 and shall be reimbursed for travel 10 expenses in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060 which shall be 11 paid out of the electrical license fund, upon vouchers approved by the 12 director ((of labor and industries)). 13

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The governor shall appoint the member representing outside line workers within ninety days after the effective date of this act.

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
