- 1 AN ACT Relating to a salary survey report by the marine employees'
- 2 commission; amending RCW 47.64.220; adding a new section to chapter

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.64.220 and 1989 c 327 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) Prior to collective bargaining, the marine employees'
- 8 commission shall conduct a salary survey. The results of the survey
- 9 shall be published in a report which shall be a public document
- 10 comparing wages, hours, employee benefits, and conditions of employment
- 11 of involved ferry employees with those of public and private sector
- 12 employees in states along the west coast of the United States,
- 13 including Alaska, and in British Columbia doing directly comparable but
- 14 not necessarily identical work, giving consideration to factors

- 13 (section 1 of this act) is a clarification of existing law and applies
- 14 retroactively.
