1 AN ACT Relating to business and occupation and utility tax 2 deductions for small water, sewer, and irrigation districts with less 3 than one thousand five hundred customers; amending RCW 82.04.312 and 4 82.16.042; and providing an expiration date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 Sec. 1. RCW 82.04.312 and 1998 c 316 s 1 are each amended to read 7 as follows:

8 (1) This chapter does not apply to amounts received for water <u>or</u> 9 <u>sewer</u> services supplied by a water-sewer district established under 10 Title 57 RCW or by an irrigation district established under Title 87 11 RCW that:

12 (a) Has less than one thousand five hundred connections; and

(b) Charges residential water <u>or sewer</u> rates that exceed one hundred twenty-five percent of the state-wide average residential water <u>or sewer</u> rate published on or before July 1st of each year by the department of health.

17 (2) This chapter does not apply to amounts received for water <u>or</u>
18 <u>sewer</u> services supplied by a water <u>or sewer</u> system that:

(a) Is operated or owned by a qualified satellite management agency
under RCW 70.116.134;

(b) Has less than two hundred connections; and

4 (c) Charges residential water <u>or sewer</u> rates that exceed one 5 hundred twenty-five percent of the state-wide average residential water 6 <u>or sewer</u> rate published on or before July 1st of each year by the 7 department of health.

8 (3) This chapter does not apply to amounts received for sewerage 9 collection services supplied by a water-sewer district established 10 under Title 57 RCW or by an irrigation district established under Title 11 <u>87 RCW that:</u>

12 (a) Has less than one thousand five hundred connections; and

(b) Charges residential sewer rates that exceed one hundred twenty five percent of the state-wide average residential sewer rate published
on or before July 1st of each year by the department of ecology.

16 <u>(4)</u> To receive an exemption under this section, <u>the water-sewer</u> 17 <u>district</u>, the water <u>or sewer</u> system or irrigation district shall supply 18 to the department of revenue proof that an amount equal to at least 19 ninety percent of the value of the exemption shall be expended to 20 repair, equip, maintain, and upgrade the water <u>or sewer</u> system.

21 (((4))) (5) The department of health and ecology may use rate 22 information provided in surveys and reports produced by the association 23 of Washington cities, an association of elected officials, or other 24 municipal association to estimate a state-wide average residential 25 water and sewer rate.

26 (((5))) <u>(6)</u> This section expires July 1, 2004.

27 **Sec. 2.** RCW 82.16.042 and 1998 c 316 s 2 are each amended to read 28 as follows:

(1) This chapter does not apply to amounts received for water or sewer services supplied by a water-sewer district established under Title 57 RCW or by an irrigation district established under Title 87 RCW that:

33 (a) Has less than one thousand five hundred connections; and

(b) Charges residential water <u>or sewer</u> rates that exceed one hundred twenty-five percent of the state-wide average residential water <u>or sewer</u> rate published on or before July 1st of each year by the department of health.

1 (2) This chapter does not apply to amounts received for water 2 services supplied by a water <u>or sewer</u> system that:

3 (a) Is operated or owned by a qualified satellite management agency4 under RCW 70.116.134;

(b) Has less than two hundred connections; and

6 (c) Charges residential water <u>or sewer</u> rates that exceed one 7 hundred twenty-five percent of the state-wide average residential water 8 <u>or sewer</u> rate.

9 (3) This chapter does not apply to amounts received for sewerage 10 collection services supplied by a water-sewer district established 11 under Title 57 RCW or by an irrigation district established under Title 12 <u>87 RCW that:</u>

13 (a) Has less than one thousand five hundred connections; and

(b) Charges residential sewer rates that exceed one hundred twenty five percent of the state-wide average residential sewer rate published
on or before July 1st of each year by the department of ecology.

17 <u>(4)</u> To receive an exemption under this section, <u>the water-sewer</u> 18 <u>district</u>, the water <u>or sewer</u> system, or irrigation district shall 19 supply to the department of revenue proof that an amount equal to at 20 least ninety percent of the value of the exemption shall be expended to 21 repair, equip, maintain, and upgrade the water <u>or sewer</u> system.

(((4))) (5) For the purposes of this section, "state-wide average residential water rate <u>and state-wide average residential sewer rate</u>" means the state-wide average residential water <u>or sewer</u> rate published under RCW 82.04.312.

26 (((5))) (6) This section expires July 1, ((2004)) 2005.
