- 1 AN ACT Relating to catch record card requirements for recreational
- 2 crab fishers; adding a new section to chapter 77.32 RCW; and creating
- 3 a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the department of
- 6 fish and wildlife manages the recreational crab fishery through an
- 7 imprecise system of catch estimation. Increased harvest data accuracy
- 8 is needed for the recreational crab fishery and this goal can be
- 9 accomplished through the establishment of a crab catch record card
- 10 system.
- 11 The department shall utilize data from the crab catch record cards
- 12 in preparing catch reports and in catch-sharing negotiations.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 77.32 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 In addition to a combination fishing license, saltwater fishing
- 16 license, temporary fishing license, or a family fishing weekend
- 17 license, a crab catch record card is required to fish for and harvest

- 1 crabs in the recreational fishery. The crab catch record card shall be 2 administered under the rules of the commission.
- 3 The commission shall require that fishers carry their card when
- 4 fishing for crab, that harvest data be immediately entered in ink onto
- 5 the card when crab are harvested, and that it be mandatory that the
- 6 card is returned to the department when it has expired.
