1 AN ACT Relating to occupational health standards for airborne 2 pathogens and waterborne pathogens; adding a new section to chapter 3 49.17 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that workers engaged 6 in the handling, transportation, treatment, and disposal of biomedical 7 waste may be exposed to elevated risks of contracting diseases from 8 pathogens conveyed by air or water. These risks may be reduced by 9 application of occupational health standards for airborne pathogens and 10 waterborne pathogens that are comparable to those developed to protect 11 workers from bloodborne pathogens.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 49.17 RCW 13 to read as follows:

14 The department of labor and industries, in consultation with the 15 department of health, shall develop and adopt by rule occupational
