- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.09 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Effective January 1, 2002, the department shall offer
- 7 acupuncture services as part of its care and services offered under
- 8 this chapter.
- 9 (2) Providers of acupuncture services under this chapter must be 10 licensed as provided under chapter 18.06 RCW.
- 11 (3) The department shall limit the number of acupunctural
- 12 treatments provided under this section to a maximum of eight per year
- 13 per patient and may develop additional appropriate limitations for the
- 14 utilization of acupuncture services.

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
