- 1 not medically necessary shall be deemed to be the decision of the 2 medical director designated in section 1 of this act.
- 3 (2) The definitions in this subsection apply throughout this 4 section, unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- 5 (a) "Health insurer" has the same meaning as provided in section 1 6 of this act.
- 7 (b) "Services" means medical care or items from a person licensed 8 under chapter 18.57, 18.57A, 18.71, or 18.71A RCW, or as defined in RCW 9 18.79.050.
- 10 (3) The medical quality assurance commission and the state board of 11 osteopathic medicine and surgery may adopt rules to implement this 12 section.
