- 1 AN ACT Relating to standards for school security personnel; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 28A.300 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.300 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 The office of the superintendent of public instruction shall
- 7 coordinate with the Washington association of sheriffs and police
- 8 chiefs, the Washington state association of prosecuting attorneys, the
- 9 Washington state trial lawyers association, the Washington state
- 10 patrol, school districts, school employee groups, and others to develop
- 11 and recommend to the superintendent of public instruction state-wide
- 12 mandatory minimum standards for training school security personnel.
- 13 The superintendent shall adopt the standards by rule. Upon adoption,
- 14 the standards shall be in effect in every school district within the
- 15 state and shall apply to persons hired on or after the effective date
- 16 of this section.
- 17 For the purposes of this section, "school security personnel" means
- 18 persons employed or contracted for by a school district or educational
- 19 service district whose primary duty with the district is security
