- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) It is unlawful for any person to direct light from a laser
 - pointer at a school bus driver, transit driver, or other public
- 8 transportation employee in the performance of his or her duties, or the
- 9 marked service vehicle of any such individual.
- 10 (2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 1 civil infraction under chapter 7.80 RCW.
- 12 (3) For the purposes of this section, "laser pointer" means any
- 13 device that emits light amplified by the stimulated emission of
- 14 radiation that is visible to the human eye.
