1 AN ACT Relating to limitations on the regular property tax levies 2 of taxing districts; amending RCW 84.55.0101; and creating a new 3 section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 84.55.0101 and 1997 c 3 s 204 (Referendum Bill No. 47)
6 are each amended to read as follows:

7 (1) Upon a finding of substantial need, the legislative authority 8 of a taxing district other than the state may provide, by ordinance or 9 <u>resolution</u>, for the use of a limit factor under this chapter of one 10 hundred six percent or less. <u>The ordinance or resolution shall specify</u> 11 <u>the specific activities</u>, projects, and programs that will be funded in 12 <u>the following year from the added revenues and why they cannot be</u> 13 <u>funded from the revenues that would otherwise have been generated</u>.

14 (2) In districts with legislative authorities of four members or 15 less, two-thirds of the members must approve ((an)) the ordinance or 16 resolution under this section. In districts with <u>legislative</u> 17 <u>authorities of</u> more than four members, a majority plus one vote must 18 approve ((an)) the ordinance or resolution under this section.

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1 (3) The new limit factor shall be effective for taxes collected in 2 the following year only.

3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. This act applies to taxes levied for 4 collection in 2000 and thereafter.

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
