- 1 AN ACT Relating to open public meetings; and amending RCW
- 2 42.30.030, 42.30.040, 42.30.060, and 42.30.070.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.30.030 and 1971 ex.s. c 250 s 3 are each amended to 5 read as follows:
- 6 All meetings of the governing body of a public agency shall be open
- 7 and public and all persons shall be permitted to attend any meeting of
- 8 the governing body of a public agency, except as otherwise provided in
- 9 this chapter.
- 10 An agenda shall be posted at least seventy-two hours before each
- 11 regular meeting and twenty-four hours before each special meeting.
- 12 Each agenda item must be described with enough specificity to indicate
- 13 the subject matter or action to be considered, but need not exceed
- 14 <u>twenty words per agenda item.</u>
- 15 At least fifteen minutes shall be allotted for public comment for
- 16 each agenda item. Each person desiring to speak shall be allotted at
- 17 <u>least three minutes, except that the time allotted may be reduced</u>
- 18 proportionately if more than five people desire to speak on the agenda

- 1 item. The governing body shall accept written comments in addition to
- 2 spoken comments.
- 3 **Sec. 2.** RCW 42.30.040 and 1971 ex.s. c 250 s 4 are each amended to 4 read as follows:
- 5 A member of the public shall not be required, as a condition to
- 6 attendance at a meeting of a governing body, to register his or her
- 7 name and other information, to complete a questionnaire, or otherwise
- 8 to fulfill any condition precedent to his or her attendance.
- 9 The governing body may require persons desiring to speak or present
- 10 written comments to identify himself or herself.
- 11 Sec. 3. RCW 42.30.060 and 1989 c 42 s 1 are each amended to read
- 12 as follows:
- (1) ((No)) A governing body of a public agency ((shall)) may only
- 14 adopt ((any)) an ordinance, resolution, rule, regulation, order, or
- 15 directive((<del>, except in</del>)) <u>when:</u>
- 16 (a) Such action is taken at a meeting (i) open to the public ((and
- 17 then only at a meeting, )) and (ii) for which the date ((of which)) is
- 18 fixed by law or rule( $(\frac{1}{2})$ ) or ((at a meeting of which)) notice has been
- 19 given according to the provisions of this chapter; and
- 20 (b) The agenda for the meeting clearly indicates that the governing
- 21 body may take final action on the matter.
- 22 Any action taken at meetings failing to comply with the provisions
- 23 of this subsection shall be null and void.
- 24 (2) No governing body of a public agency at any meeting required to
- 25 be open to the public shall vote by secret ballot. Any vote taken in
- 26 violation of this subsection shall be null and void, and shall be
- 27 considered an "action" under this chapter.
- 28 **Sec. 4.** RCW 42.30.070 and 1983 c 155 s 2 are each amended to read
- 29 as follows:
- The governing body of a public agency shall provide the time for
- 31 holding regular meetings by ordinance, resolution, bylaws, or by
- 32 whatever other rule is required for the conduct of business by that
- 33 body. ((Unless otherwise provided for in the act under which the
- 34 public agency was formed,)) Meetings of ((the)) a governing body ((need
- 35 not)) of a public agency defined under RCW 42.30.020(1)(a) shall be
- 36 held within the state. Meetings of a governing body of a public agency

defined under RCW 42.30.020(1)(b) shall be held within the boundaries 1 of the territory over which the public agency exercises jurisdiction. 2 Meetings of a governing body of a public agency defined under RCW 3 4 42.30.020(1) (c) or (d) shall be held within the boundaries of the territory of a public agency served by the subagency or policy group. 5 If at any time any regular meeting falls on a holiday, such regular 6 7 meeting shall be held on the next business day. If, by reason of fire, 8 flood, earthquake, or other emergency, there is a need for expedited 9 action by a governing body to meet the emergency, the presiding officer 10 of the governing body may provide for a meeting site other than the regular meeting site and the notice and agenda requirements of this 11 chapter shall be suspended during such emergency. It shall not be a 12 violation of the requirements of this chapter for a majority of the 13 members of a governing body to travel together or gather for purposes 14 15 other than a regular meeting or a special meeting as these terms are used in this chapter: PROVIDED, That they take no action as defined in 16 17 this chapter.
