- 1 AN ACT Relating to certifying reflexologists in the practice of
- 2 reflexology; amending RCW 18.108.010 and 18.108.030; and adding new
- 3 sections to chapter 18.108 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.108.010 and 1997 c 297 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires, the 8 following meanings shall apply:
- 9 (1) "Board" means the Washington state board of massage.
- 10 (2) "Certified reflexologist" means a person who provides
 11 reflexology services in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.
- 12 <u>(3)</u> "Massage" and "massage therapy" mean a health care service
- 13 involving the external manipulation or pressure of soft tissue for
- 14 therapeutic purposes. Massage therapy includes techniques such as
- 15 tapping, compressions, friction, Swedish gymnastics or movements,
- 16 gliding, kneading, shaking, and facial or connective tissue stretching,
- 17 with or without the aids of superficial heat, cold, water, lubricants,
- 18 or salts. Massage therapy does not include diagnosis or attempts to
- 19 adjust or manipulate any articulations of the body or spine or

- 1 mobilization of these articulations by the use of a thrusting force,
- 2 nor does it include genital manipulation.
- 3 $((\frac{3}{1}))$ (4) "Massage business" means the operation of a business
- 4 where massages are given.
- 5 <u>(5)</u> "Massage practitioner" means an individual licensed under this
- 6 chapter.
- 7 (((4))) (6) "Secretary" means the secretary of health or the
- 8 secretary's designee.
- 9 ((5) Massage business means the operation of a business where
- 10 massages are given.))
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 18.108 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 Certified reflexologists shall meet educational requirements as set
- 14 by the board subject to the approval of the secretary by rule. The
- 15 educational requirements shall meet a minimum standard of educational
- 16 hours of coursework specific to the practice of reflexology as
- 17 determined by rule.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 18.108 RCW
- 19 to read as follows:
- No person may practice reflexology without receiving a certificate
- 21 to practice reflexology from the board.
- 22 **Sec. 4.** RCW 18.108.030 and 1995 c 198 s 15 are each amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- 24 (1) No person may practice or represent himself or herself as a
- 25 massage practitioner without first applying for and receiving from the
- 26 department a license to practice.
- 27 (2) A person represents himself or herself as a massage
- 28 practitioner when the person adopts or uses any title or any
- 29 description of services that incorporates one or more of the following
- 30 terms or designations: Massage, massage practitioner, massage
- 31 therapist, massage therapy, therapeutic massage, massage technician,
- 32 massage technology, massagist, masseur, masseuse, myotherapist or
- 33 myotherapy, touch therapist, reflexologist, unless certified under this

- 1 chapter, acupressurist, body therapy or body therapist, or any
- 2 derivation of those terms that implies a massage technique or method.
