- 1 AN ACT Relating to duties of drivers involved in accidents;
- 2 amending RCW 46.52.020 and 13.40.0357; reenacting and amending RCW
- 3 9.94A.320; and prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.52.020 and 1990 c 210 s 2 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) A driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in
- 8 the injury to or death of any person shall immediately stop such
- 9 vehicle at the scene of such accident or as close thereto as possible
- 10 but shall then forthwith return to, and in every event remain at, the
- 11 scene of such accident until he or she has fulfilled the requirements
- 12 of subsection (3) of this section; every such stop shall be made
- 13 without obstructing traffic more than is necessary.
- 14 (2) The driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting
- 15 only in damage to a vehicle which is driven or attended by any person
- 16 or damage to other property shall immediately stop such vehicle at the
- 17 scene of such accident or as close thereto as possible and shall
- 18 forthwith return to, and in any event shall remain at, the scene of
- 19 such accident until he or she has fulfilled the requirements of

subsection (3) of this section; every such stop shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

- 3 (3) Unless otherwise provided in subsection (7) of this section the 4 driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or 5 death of any person or damage to any vehicle which is driven or attended by any person or damage to other property shall give his or 6 7 <u>her</u> name, address, insurance company, insurance policy number, and 8 vehicle license number and shall exhibit his or her vehicle driver's 9 license to any person struck or injured or the driver or any occupant 10 of, or any person attending, any such vehicle collided with and shall render to any person injured in such accident reasonable assistance, 11 including the carrying or the making of arrangements for the carrying 12 13 of such person to a physician or hospital for medical treatment if it is apparent that such treatment is necessary or if such carrying is 14 15 requested by the injured person or on his or her behalf. Under no 16 circumstances shall the rendering of assistance or other compliance 17 with the provisions of this subsection be evidence of the liability of any driver for such accident. 18
- (4)(a) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (1) of this section failing to stop or comply with any of the requirements of subsection (3) of this section ((under said circumstances shall be)) in the case of an accident resulting in death is guilty of a class B felony and, upon conviction, shall be punished pursuant to RCW 9A.20.020.
- 25 (b) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (1) of this 26 section failing to stop or comply with any of the requirements of 27 subsection (3) of this section in the case of an accident resulting in 28 injury is guilty of a class C felony and, upon conviction, shall be 29 punished pursuant to RCW 9A.20.020((: PROVIDED, That)).
- 30 <u>(c)</u> This ((provision)) subsection shall not apply to any person 31 injured or incapacitated by such accident to the extent of being 32 physically incapable of complying ((herewith)) with this section.
 - (5) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection (2) of this section failing to stop or to comply with any of the requirements of subsection (3) of this section under said circumstances shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor: PROVIDED, That this provision shall not apply to any person injured or incapacitated by such accident to the extent of being physically incapable of complying herewith.

- 1 (6) The license or permit to drive or any nonresident privilege to 2 drive of any person convicted under this section or any local ordinance 3 consisting of substantially the same language as this section of 4 failure to stop and give information or render aid following an 5 accident with any vehicle driven or attended by any person shall be 6 revoked by the department.
- 7 (7) If none of the persons specified are in condition to receive 8 the information to which they otherwise would be entitled under 9 subsection (3) of this section, and no police officer is present, the 10 driver of any vehicle involved in such accident after fulfilling all other requirements of subsections (1) and (3) of this section insofar 11 as possible on his or her part to be performed, shall forthwith report 12 13 such accident to the nearest office of the duly authorized police authority and submit thereto the information specified in subsection 14 15 (3) of this section.
