- 1 AN ACT Relating to computation of partial service credit for
- 2 classified school employees; reenacting and amending RCW 41.40.088; and
- 3 providing an expiration date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 41.40.088 and 1991 c 343 s 9 and 1991 c 35 s 96 are 6 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A plan 1 member who is employed by a school district or 8 districts, an educational service district, the state school for the
- 9 deaf, the state school for the blind, institutions of higher education,
- 10 or community colleges:
- 11 (a) Shall receive a service credit month for each month of the
- 12 period from September through August of the following year if he or she
- 13 is employed in an eligible position, earns compensation earnable for
- 14 six hundred thirty hours or more during that period, and is employed
- 15 during nine months of that period, except that a member may not receive
- 16 credit for any period prior to the member's employment in an eligible
- 17 position;
- 18 (b) If a member in an eligible position does not meet the
- 19 requirements of (a) of this subsection, the member is entitled to a

- 1 service credit month for each month of the period he or she earns
- 2 earnable compensation for seventy or more hours; and the member is
- 3 entitled to a one-quarter service credit month for those calendar
- 4 months during which he or she earned compensation for less than seventy
- 5 hours.
- 6 (2) Except for any period prior to the member's employment in an
- 7 eligible position, a plan 2 member who is employed by a school district
- 8 or districts, an educational service district, the state school for the
- 9 blind, the state school for the deaf, institutions of higher education,
- 10 or community colleges:
- 11 (a) Shall receive a service credit month for each month of the
- 12 period from September through August of the following year if he or she
- 13 is employed in an eligible position, earns compensation earnable for
- 14 eight hundred ten hours or more during that period, and is employed
- 15 during nine months of that period;
- 16 (b) If a member in an eligible position for each month of the
- 17 period from September through August of the following year does not
- 18 meet the hours requirements of (a) of this subsection, the member is
- 19 entitled to one-half service credit month for each month of the period
- 20 if he or she earns earnable compensation for at least six hundred
- 21 thirty hours but less than eight hundred ten hours during that period,
- 22 and is employed nine months of that period.
- 23 (c) In all other instances, a member in an eligible position is
- 24 entitled to service credit months as follows:
- 25 (i) One service credit month for each month in which compensation
- 26 is earned for ninety or more hours;
- 27 (ii) One-half service credit month for each month in which
- 28 compensation is earned for at least seventy hours but less than ninety
- 29 hours; and
- 30 (iii) One-quarter service credit month for each month in which
- 31 compensation is earned for less than seventy hours.
- 32 (d) The provisions of this subsection (2) are applicable to plan 2
- 33 members prospectively from October 1, 1977.
- 34 (3) The department shall adopt rules implementing this section.
