
SENATE BILL 6109

State of Washington 56th Legislature 1999 1st Special Session

1 AN ACT Relating to funding school safety programs; creating a new
2 section; making appropriations; providing an effective date; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The sum of three million dollars, or as much
6 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund to
7 the superintendent of public instruction for the biennium ending June
8 30, 2001, for matching grants to enhance security in schools. This
9 appropriation is a supplement to the five million nine hundred twenty-
10 three thousand dollars school security appropriation contained in
11 Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill No. 5180, section 501(2)(e) (omnibus
12 operating budget act), and shall be expended in the same manner and for
13 the same purposes.

14 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** The sum of two million five hundred thousand
15 dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from
16 the general fund to the superintendent of public instruction for the
17 biennium ending June 30, 2001, for school safety programs for
18 prevention and intervention. The funds shall be allocated to each

1 educational service district based on the full-time equivalent
2 enrollment in the educational service district in the prior school
3 year. The funds may be expended for proven-effective programs to
4 improve safety in schools, including: Peer counseling and peer
5 mediation; nonviolence and leadership training for staff and students;
6 establishing local hotlines; and start-up grants for before-and-after
7 school programs for at-risk youth. The programs may be provided by
8 educational service districts or consortiums of educational service
9 districts or local school districts. The specific programs to be
10 provided shall be determined by each educational service district in
11 consultation with its school districts.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The sum of one million dollars, or as much
13 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund to
14 the superintendent of public instruction for the biennium ending June
15 30, 2001, for alternative school start-up grants. This appropriation
16 is a supplement to the two million dollars alternative school start-up
17 appropriation contained in Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill No. 5180,
18 section 501(2)(1) (omnibus operating budget act), and shall be expended
19 in the same manner and for the same purposes.

20 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** The sum of five hundred thousand dollars, or
21 as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general
22 fund to the superintendent of public instruction for the biennium
23 ending June 30, 2001, for school safety plan grants. This
24 appropriation is a supplement to the one million dollars safety plan
25 appropriation contained in Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill No. 5180,
26 section 501(2)(q) (omnibus operating budget act), and shall be expended
27 in the same manner and for the same purposes.

28 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** The biennial appropriations in this act
29 shall be allotted by the office of financial management evenly between
30 fiscal year 2000 and fiscal year 2001.

31 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 6.** This act is necessary for the immediate
32 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

1 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
2 July 1, 1999.
