- 1 AN ACT Relating to requirements for operating a motorcycle on
- 2 Washington highways; amending RCW 46.20.505, 46.20.515, and 46.30.020;
- 3 and adding a new section to chapter 82.12 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.505 and 1999 c . . . (SB 5374) s 9 are each 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Every person applying for a special endorsement of a driver's
- 8 license authorizing such person to drive a motorcycle or a motor-driven
- 9 cycle shall pay ((an examination)) a fee of two dollars which is not
- 10 refundable. In addition, the endorsement fee for the initial
- 11 motorcycle endorsement shall be six dollars and the subsequent renewal
- 12 endorsement fee shall be fourteen dollars. The initial and renewal
- 13 endorsement fees shall be deposited in the motorcycle safety education
- 14 account of the highway safety fund.
- 15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 46.20.515 and 1999 c . . . (SB 5374) s 11 are each
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 The motorcycle endorsement examination must emphasize maneuvers
- 18 necessary for on-street operation, including emergency braking and

- 1 turning as may be required to avoid an impending collision. The
- 2 department may waive all or part of the examination for persons who
- 3 <u>satisfactorily complete the voluntary motorcycle operator training and</u>
- 4 education program authorized under RCW 46.20.520.
- 5 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.30.020 and 1991 sp.s. c 25 s 1 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1)(a) No person may operate a motor vehicle subject to registration under chapter 46.16 RCW in this state unless the person is 8 9 insured under a motor vehicle liability policy with liability limits of at least the amounts provided in RCW 46.29.090, is self-insured as 10 provided in RCW 46.29.630, is covered by a certificate of deposit in 11 12 conformance with RCW 46.29.550, or is covered by a liability bond of at least the amounts provided in RCW 46.29.090. Written proof of 13 14 financial responsibility for motor vehicle operation must be provided 15 on the request of a law enforcement officer in the format specified 16 under RCW 46.30.030.
- 17 (b) A person who drives a motor vehicle that is required to be registered in another state that requires drivers and owners of 18 19 vehicles in that state to maintain insurance or financial responsibility shall, when requested by a law enforcement officer, 20 provide evidence of financial responsibility or insurance as is 21 required by the laws of the state in which the vehicle is registered. 22
- (c) When asked to do so by a law enforcement officer, failure to display an insurance identification card as specified under RCW 46.30.030 creates a presumption that the person does not have motor vehicle insurance.
- (d) Failure to provide proof of motor vehicle insurance is a traffic infraction and is subject to penalties as set by the supreme court under RCW 46.63.110 or community service.
- 30 (2) If a person cited for a violation of subsection (1) of this section appears in person before the court and provides written 31 32 evidence that at the time the person was cited, he or she was in 33 compliance with the financial responsibility requirements of subsection (1) of this section, the citation shall be dismissed. 34 In lieu of personal appearance, a person cited for a violation of subsection (1) 35 36 of this section may, before the date scheduled for the person's appearance before the court, submit by mail to the court written 37 evidence that at the time the person was cited, he or she was in 38

- 14 liability policies required by this chapter but only those certified
- 15 for the purposes stated in chapter 46.29 RCW.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 This chapter does not apply to the use of motorcycles that are
- 19 loaned to the department of licensing exclusively for purposes of
- 20 providing motorcycle training under RCW 46.20.520, or to persons
- 21 contracting with the department to provide such training.
