1 AN ACT Relating to the insurance commissioner; amending RCW 2 43.01.010, 48.02.010, 43.17.020, and 42.17.2401; and reenacting and 3 amending RCW 43.17.010.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.01.010 and 1965 c 8 s 43.01.010 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 The governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, treasurer, 8 auditor, attorney general, superintendent of public instruction, and 9 commissioner of public lands((, and insurance commissioner,)) shall 10 hold office for the term of four years, and until their successors are 11 elected and qualified; and the term shall commence on the Wednesday 12 after the second Monday of January following their election.

13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 48.02.010 and 1947 c 79 s .02.01 are each amended to 14 read as follows:

(1) There shall be an insurance commissioner of this state who shall be ((elected at the time and in the manner that other state officers are elected)) appointed by the governor, with the consent of the senate. (2) The commissioner in office ((at)) on the effective date of this
((code)) act shall continue in office for the remainder of the term for
which he was elected and until his successor is ((duly elected and
qualified)) appointed.

5 (3) "Commissioner," where used in this ((code)) <u>title</u>, means the 6 insurance commissioner of this state.

7 Sec. 3. RCW 43.17.010 and 1993 sp.s. c 2 s 16, 1993 c 472 s 17, and 1993 c 280 s 18 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows: 8 9 There shall be departments of the state government which shall be known as (1) the department of social and health services, (2) the 10 11 department of ecology, (3) the department of labor and industries, (4) 12 the department of agriculture, (5) the department of fish and wildlife, (6) the department of transportation, (7) the department of licensing, 13 14 (8) the department of general administration, (9) the department of 15 community, trade, and economic development, (10) the department of veterans affairs, (11) the department of revenue, (12) the department 16 of retirement systems, (13) the department of corrections, ((and)) (14) 17 18 the department of health, ((and)) (15) the department of financial 19 institutions, and (16) the office of the insurance commissioner, which shall be charged with the execution, enforcement, and administration of 20 21 such laws, and invested with such powers and required to perform such 22 duties, as the legislature may provide.

23 Sec. 4. RCW 43.17.020 and 1995 1st sp.s. c 2 s 2 are each amended 24 to read as follows:

There shall be a chief executive officer of each department to be 25 known as: (1) The secretary of social and health services, (2) the 26 27 director of ecology, (3) the director of labor and industries, (4) the 28 director of agriculture, (5) the director of fish and wildlife, (6) the 29 secretary of transportation, (7) the director of licensing, (8) the director of general administration, (9) the director of community, 30 trade, and economic development, (10) the director of veterans affairs, 31 (11) the director of revenue, (12) the director of retirement systems, 32 33 (13) the secretary of corrections, ((and)) (14) the secretary of health, ((and)) (15) the director of financial institutions, and (16) 34 35 the office of the insurance commissioner.

36 Such officers, except the secretary of transportation and the 37 director of fish and wildlife, shall be appointed by the governor, with 1 the consent of the senate, and hold office at the pleasure of the 2 governor. The secretary of transportation shall be appointed by the 3 transportation commission as prescribed by RCW 47.01.041. The director 4 of fish and wildlife shall be appointed by the fish and wildlife 5 commission as prescribed by RCW 77.04.055.

6 **Sec. 5.** RCW 42.17.2401 and 1996 c 186 s 504 are each amended to 7 read as follows:

8 For the purposes of RCW 42.17.240, the term "executive state 9 officer" includes:

administrative law 10 (1)The chief judge, the director of agriculture, ((the administrator of the office of marine safety,)) the 11 12 administrator of the Washington basic health plan, the director of the department of services for the blind, the director of the state system 13 14 of community and technical colleges, the director of community, trade, 15 and economic development, the secretary of corrections, the director of 16 ecology, the commissioner of employment security, the chairman of the energy facility site evaluation council, the secretary of the state 17 18 finance committee, the director of financial management, the director 19 of fish and wildlife, the executive secretary of the forest practices appeals board, the director of the gambling commission, the director of 20 general administration, the secretary of health, the administrator of 21 22 the Washington state health care authority, the executive secretary of 23 the health care facilities authority, the executive secretary of the 24 higher education facilities authority, the executive secretary of the 25 horse racing commission, the executive secretary of the human rights commission, the executive secretary of the indeterminate sentence 26 review board, the director of the department of information services, 27 the insurance commissioner, the director of the interagency committee 28 29 for outdoor recreation, the executive director of the state investment 30 board, the director of labor and industries, the director of licensing, the director of the lottery commission, the director of the office of 31 minority and women's business enterprises, the director of parks and 32 recreation, the director of personnel, the executive director of the 33 34 public disclosure commission, the director of retirement systems, the director of revenue, the secretary of social and health services, the 35 36 chief of the Washington state patrol, the executive secretary of the board of tax appeals, the secretary of transportation, the secretary of 37 38 the utilities and transportation commission, the director of veterans

(3) Each professional staff member of the legislature; and
