- 1 AN ACT Relating to environmental review of surface mining in flood
- 2 plains; adding a new section to chapter 43.21C RCW; adding a new

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the flood plains
- 6 of the state's rivers are a part of the river system and have a
- 7 significant function, in respect to channel movement and fish habitat,
- 8 which is especially important in light of the listings and potential
- 9 listings of fish as threatened or endangered under the federal
- 10 endangered species act. The legislature further finds that the
- 11 potential impacts of surface mining on the significant functions of
- 12 flood plains are site-specific, consistently requiring thorough
- 13 environmental review of individual projects. The legislature also
- 14 finds that the state environmental policy act, rules adopted to
- 15 implement it, and other applicable environmental and land use laws
- 16 prevent unnecessary duplication of environmental review, appropriately
- 17 assign responsibilities among local governments and state agencies with
- 18 regulatory jurisdiction, and help to protect property and its value.

- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 78.44 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 Except for metals mining and milling operations subject to RCW
- 12 78.56.050, an environmental impact statement must be prepared for any
- 13 new or expanded public or private surface mine when all or part of the
- 14 proposed mine falls within a flood plain as defined in WAC 173-22-030.
