- 1 AN ACT Relating to actions against churches; adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 4.08 RCW; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The legislature finds
- 5 that a church is not liable for the intentional or criminal acts of a
  - third party unless the church has either a duty to control the third
- 7 party or a duty to protect the victim. Recent court decisions, such as
- 8 Funkhouser v. Wilson, 138 Wash.2d 699, 985 P.2d 262 (1999), have
- 9 confused these theories of liability. It is the intent of the
- 10 legislature to clarify when an action in tort based on the intentional
- 11 or criminal act of a third party may be maintained against a church.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 4.08 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:

- 14 ACTION AGAINST CHURCHES. An action in tort based on the
- 15 intentional or criminal act of a third party may not be maintained
- 16 against a church unless the act occurred while:
- 17 (1) The third party was working in a paid or a volunteer position
- 18 for the church;

- 1 (2) The victim was on the premises of the church;
- 2 (3) The victim was in the custody of the church; or
- 3 (4) The victim was participating in an activity sponsored or 4 organized by the church.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** CAPTIONS. Captions used in this act are not 6 any part of the law.
