- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.13 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) No child may be placed in out-of-home care under this chapter
- 8 or chapter 13.34 RCW when there is a conflict of interest on the part
- 9 of any adult residing in the home in which the child is to be placed.
- 10 A conflict of interest exists when:
- 11 (a) There is an adult in the home who, as a result of: (i) His or
- 12 her employment; and (ii) an allegation of abuse or neglect of the
- 13 child, conducts or has conducted an investigation of the allegation; or
- 14 (b) The child has been, is, or is likely to be a witness in any
- 15 cause of action against any adult in the home when the cause includes:
- 16 (i) An allegation of abuse or neglect against the child or any sibling
- 17 of the child; or (ii) a claim of damages resulting from wrongful
- 18 interference with the parent-child relationship of the child and his or
- 19 her biological or adoptive parent.

1 (2) The prohibition set forth in subsection (1) of this section may 2 not be waived or deferred by the department under any circumstance or 3 at the request of any person, regardless of who has made the request or 4 the length of time of the requested placement.
