- 8 (1) Have more than one nonscientific member on the board. More
- 9 than one nonscientific member must participate in any portion of a
- 10 board meeting where research plans or protocols are reviewed;
- 11 (2) Have more than one noninstitutional board member. The same
- 12 person cannot represent both a nonscientific and a noninstitutional
- 13 board member. More than one noninstitutional board member must
- 14 participate in any portion of a board meeting where research plans or
- 15 protocols are reviewed;
- 16 (3) Have scientists comprise at least one-third, but no more than
- 17 two-thirds of the board membership; and

- 1 (4) Invalidate the vote of any board member with a property or 2 fiscal interest in the research being reviewed. No board member shall
- 3 vote on research in which he or she has a property or fiscal interest.
