- 1 AN ACT Relating to industrial insurance premiums for employers with
- 2 drug-free workplace programs; amending RCW 49.82.901; creating a new
- 3 section; and providing an expiration date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 49.82.901 and 1996 c 127 s 18 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
- 7 Sections 1 through <u>14 and</u> 16 of this act ((shall)) expire January
- $8 \quad 1, \quad ((\frac{2001}{2001})) \quad \underline{2004}.$
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The department of labor and industries, in
- 10 full consultation with the department of social and health services,
- 11 shall conduct a cost-benefit evaluation of the drug-free workplace
- 12 program. The evaluation shall take into account both the qualitative
- 13 and quantitative benefits and costs of the program. If the department
- 14 of labor and industries contracts for the performance of any or all of
- 15 the evaluation, no more than ten percent of the contract amount may be
- 16 used to cover indirect expenses. The departments of labor and
- 17 industries and social and health services shall submit an interim

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- 1 report to the legislature on September 1, 2001, and shall issue a final
- 2 evaluation report on December 1, 2002.

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
