- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1)(a) A credit card issuer may not issue a
- 5 credit card to a minor domiciled in this state without first obtaining
 - permission to do so from the parent, guardian, or person having legal
- 7 custody and control of the minor.
- 8 (b) This subsection does not apply to the issuance of a credit card
- 9 to a minor who has been emancipated under chapter 13.64 RCW.
- 10 (2) A credit card issuer may not issue a credit card to a person
- 11 domiciled in this state who is eighteen, nineteen, or twenty years of
- 12 age unless:
- 13 (a) Permission is obtained from the parent or other person who
- 14 claimed the applicant as a dependent on their most recent federal
- 15 income tax return;
- 16 (b) The application includes a copy of the applicant's most recent
- 17 federal income tax return which indicates that the applicant claimed
- 18 their personal exemption in the computation of their own tax liability;

- 1 (c) The applicant, while a minor, obtained a decree of emancipation 2 under chapter 13.64 RCW.
 - (3) For the purposes of this section:

- 4 (a) "Credit card" means a card or device issued under an agreement 5 by which the issuer gives to a cardholder residing in this state the 6 privilege of obtaining credit from the issuer or other persons in 7 purchasing or leasing property or services, obtaining loans, or 8 otherwise.
- 9 (b) "Credit care issuer" means a financial institution, a lender 10 other than a financial institution, or a merchant that receives 11 applications and issues credit cards to individuals.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Section 1 of this act constitutes a new 13 chapter in Title 19 RCW.
