## SENATE BILL 6283

- AN ACT Relating to transportation projects; amending RCW 47.20.755,
- 2 47.20.765, and 47.20.775; and providing an expiration date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.20.755 and 1998 c 195 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- The department of transportation shall develop((, by January 1,
- 7 1999,)) a process for awarding competitively bid highway construction
- 8 contracts for projects ((over ten million dollars)) that may be
- 9 constructed using a design-build procedure. As used in this section,
- 10 "design-build procedure" means a method of contracting under which the
- 11 department of transportation contracts with another party for such
- 12 party to both design and build the structures, facilities, and other
- 13 items specified in the contract.
- 14 The process developed by the department shall, at a minimum,
- 15 include the scope of services required under the design-build
- 16 procedure, contractor prequalification requirements, criteria for
- 17 evaluating technical information and project costs, contractor
- 18 selection criteria, and an issue resolution procedure. If a request

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- 1 for proposal will be used, the requirements of RCW 39.10.050 (4), (5),
- 2 and (6) apply.
- 3 **Sec. 2.** RCW 47.20.765 and 1998 c 195 s 4 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
- The department may use the design-build procedure for public works projects ((over ten million dollars)) where:
- 7 (1) The construction activities are highly specialized and a 8 design-build approach, as defined in RCW 47.20.755, is critical in 9 developing the construction methodology; or
- 10 (2) The projects selected provide opportunity for greater 11 innovation and efficiencies between the designer and the builder; or
- 12 (3) Significant savings in project delivery time would be realized.
- 13 **Sec. 3.** RCW 47.20.775 and 1998 c 195 s 6 are each amended to read 14 as follows:
- 15 A demonstration program consisting of two projects must be 16 implemented using the design-build method of contracting, as prescribed
- 17 under a process developed by the department of transportation under RCW
- 18 47.20.755. ((The department shall select projects valued over ten
- 19 million dollars for the demonstration program.))
- The department shall present progress reports on the demonstration
- 21 projects to the ((<del>legislative</del>)) <u>senate and house of representatives</u>
- 22 transportation committee  $\underline{s}$  and the alternative public works oversight
- $23\,$  committee during the course of the performance of the demonstration
- 24 projects. The department shall present a final detailed report to the
- 25 ((<del>legislative</del>)) <u>senate and house of representatives</u> transportation
- 26 committees within one year of completion of the demonstration projects.
- 27 The report must detail the advantages and disadvantages of the design-
- 28 build construction process and make recommendations for possible
- 29 changes in law, and in how the process may be used for future
- 30 department projects.
- 31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Sections 1 through 3 of this act expire 32 April 30, 2001.

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
