1 AN ACT Relating to timber sales; and creating a new section.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature directs that the attorney
4 general, in conjunction with the prosecuting attorneys from Stevens,
5 Pend Oreille, Ferry, and Okanogan counties, bring suit in the proper
6 federal court of jurisdiction against the state of Idaho over the issue
7 of the timber supply stabilization act, Idaho Code Sections 58-1002
8 through 58-1008. The suit must challenge the validity of the timber
9 supply stabilization act as it relates to the federal commerce clause
10 and the federal enabling act.

11 The legislature requests that this action be taken in a timely
12 manner to protect the interests of the citizens of the state of
13 Washington.
