- 2 90.48.020, 90.48.390, and 90.64.150.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 90.48.020 and 1995 c 255 s 7 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 ((Whenever the word)) The definitions in this section apply
- throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.

- The coastal protection fund is established to be used by the
- 21 department as a revolving fund for carrying out the purposes of
- 22 restoration of natural resources under this chapter and chapter 90.56
- 23 RCW. To this fund there shall be credited penalties, fees, damages,
- 24 charges received pursuant to the provisions of this chapter and chapter
- 25 90.56 RCW, compensation for damages received under this chapter and
- 26 chapter 90.56 RCW, and an amount equivalent to one cent per gallon from
- 27 each marine use refund claim under RCW 82.36.330. However,

- 37 as follows:

The dairy waste management account is created in the custody of the 1 state treasurer. All receipts from monetary penalties levied pursuant 2 3 to violations of this chapter and from dairy farm-related violations of 4 chapter 90.48 RCW must be deposited into the account. Expenditures from the account may be used only for the commission to provide grants 5 to local conservation districts for the sole purpose of assisting dairy 6 7 producers to develop and fully implement dairy nutrient management 8 plans. Only the ((chairman)) chair of the commission or the ((chairman's)) chair's designee may authorize expenditures from the 9 10 account. The account is subject to allotment procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not required for expenditures. 11
