- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.140.155 and 1993 c 30 s 16 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- (1) A real estate appraiser from another state who is licensed or certified by another state may apply for registration to receive temporary licensing or certification in Washington by paying a fee and filing a notarized application with the department on a form provided
- 10 by the department.
- 11 (2) The director is authorized to adopt by rule the term or
- 12 <u>duration of the licensing</u> and certification privileges granted under
- 13 the provisions of this section ((shall expire ninety days from
- 14 issuance)). Licensing or certification shall not be renewed((, nor
- 15 shall an applicant receive more than two registrations within any
- 16 twelve-month period)). However, an applicant may receive an extension
- 17 of a temporary practice permit to complete an assignment, provided that
- 18 a written request is received by the department prior to the expiration
- 19 date, stating the reason for the extension.

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(3) A temporary practice permit issued under this section allows an appraiser to perform independent appraisal services required by a contract for appraisal services. The contract for appraisal services must be submitted to the department with the application for a temporary practice permit.

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- 6 <u>(4)</u> Persons granted temporary licensing or certification privileges 7 under this section shall not advertise or otherwise hold themselves out 8 as being licensed or certified by the state of Washington.
- 9 (((4))) (5) Persons granted temporary licensure or certification 10 are subject to all provisions under this chapter.

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
