- 1 AN ACT Relating to locating off-site mitigation of wetlands
- 2 impacts; adding new sections to chapter 90.74 RCW; and creating a new
- 3 section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 90.74 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The standards of this section apply to any state agency
- 8 approval of a project that impacts wetlands. Nothing in this section
- 9 creates any new authority for regulating wetlands beyond what is
- 10 specifically provided for in this section. Nothing in this section
- 11 creates any requirements for local government regulation of projects
- 12 that impact wetlands.
- 13 (2) A state agency shall not approve off-site compensatory
- 14 mitigation unless it is to be conducted in the same watershed as the
- 15 project causing wetland impacts.
- 16 (3) In addition to the limitation of subsection (2) of this
- 17 section, a state agency shall not approve off-site compensatory
- 18 mitigation of the wetland impacts of a project located within an

- 1 incorporated area or within a designated urban growth area, unless the 2 mitigation is to be conducted within five miles of the project site.
- 3 (4) For purposes of this section:
- 4 (a) "Approval" of a project that impacts wetlands includes the 5 issuance by any state agency of any regulatory permit, water quality 6 certification, or other regulatory action approving or conditioning the 7 project.
- 8 (b) "Compensatory mitigation" means the restoration, creation, or 9 enhancement of wetlands for the purpose of compensating for unavoidable 10 adverse impacts that remain after all appropriate and practicable 11 avoidance and minimization has been achieved.
- 12 (c) "Off-site compensatory mitigation" and "off-site mitigation" 13 means compensatory mitigation undertaken at a location other than the 14 project site.
- 15 (d) "Project site" means all contiguous real property used or 16 proposed to be used for the project and compensatory mitigation of 17 wetland or other impacts.
- 18 (e) "Watershed" means an area identified as a water resource 19 inventory area under WAC 173-500-040 as it exists on the effective date 20 of this section. This subsection (3) applies only within counties 21 having a population of greater than five hundred thousand on the 22 effective date of this section.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 90.74 RCW to read as follows:
- 25 The departments of ecology and fish and wildlife shall implement 26 this chapter consistent with section 1 of this act.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. Section 1 of this act applies to any state agency approval of a project that impacts wetlands where the approval is made on or after January 1, 2000.
