- 1 AN ACT Relating to the wildlife publications account; adding a new

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.12 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The wildlife publications account is created in the custody of
- the state treasurer. All receipts from the sale or distribution of
- informational materials, products, advertising, and those activities 8
- 9 listed in subsection (2) of this section must be deposited into the
- Expenditures from the account may be used only for those
- activities listed in subsection (3) of this section. Only the director 11
- of fish and wildlife or the director's designee may authorize 12
- 13 expenditures from the account. The account is subject to allotment
- 14 procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not
- 15 required for expenditures.

- 1 (b) The sale of advertisements in regulation pamphlets and other 2 appropriate mediums; and
- 3 (c) Enrollment fees in department-sponsored educational training 4 events.
  - (3) Moneys in the account may be spent only for:
- 6 (a) The development, production, reprinting, and distribution of informational and educational materials;
  - (b) Producing regulation booklets for users; and
- 9 (c) Necessary expenses associated with training activities.
- 10 (4) Regulation pamphlets may be subsidized through appropriate 11 advertising, but must be made available free of charge to the users.
- 12 (5) The director may enter into joint ventures with other agencies
- 13 and organizations to generate revenue for providing public information
- 14 and education on wildlife and hunting and fishing rules.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** RCW 77.12.185 (Publications--Authority to
