- 1 AN ACT Relating to food safety standards in schools; adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 28A.235 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the health,
- 5 safety, and welfare of Washington students is dependent upon the safe
- 6 preparation of food at Washington schools. The legislature further
- 7 finds that children are more vulnerable and susceptible to food-borne
- 8 illnesses warranting safety protections greater than might normally be
- 9 prescribed. Therefore, it is the intent of the legislature that higher
- 10 food safety standards be implemented regarding personnel engaged in
- 11 food preparation in Washington schools.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.235
- 13 RCW to read as follows:
- 14 The superintendent of public instruction shall, in consultation
- 15 with the department of health, local health jurisdictions,
- 16 representatives of food and nutrition service employees, and
- 17 representatives of the food service industry, adopt rules establishing
- 18 minimum training and permit requirements of individuals employed by

- l school districts or private schools in the handling or preparation of
- 2 food. The rules adopted under this section must exceed the standards
- 3 required under chapter 69.06 RCW. The superintendent of public
- 4 instruction's statutory authority to adopt new rules or amend
- 5 previously adopted rules under this section expires two years after the
- 6 effective date of this act.
